## THE BEAUTY OF HOUNDSLAKE

Did you know how and why our golf course once featured 50,000 azaleas plus dogwoods, camellias, hollies, and more?

As a nature lover, Bob Penland's goal was for Houndslake Country Club to be not only beautiful but colorful. He made some inquiries with other golf course developers about how much it might cost to properly landscape the course. He was told that to do it right, he would need to invest approximately $\$ 50,000$.

Before the original 18 holes were constructed, 50+ years ago, Bob hired a key employee, J.M. Fulmer as Houndslake's Greens Superintendent. Mr. Fulmer and his brother, Bob, owned and operated a nursery and had a retail store, "Fulmer's Nursery", adjacent to his brothers' grocery store on Charleston Street.

After J.M. accepted the position, he went to Bob to let him know he had a problem. He was growing azaleas and many other plants in pots, but they were located on a tract of land that was owned by someone else. Bob suggested they ride to this property to look at the plants. J.M. showed him some 50,000 azaleas in pots plus many more plantings. Bob asked him about the cost for everything, and J.M. said he was not sure how to put a price on them. Penland asked, "How about $\$ 50,000$ "? J. M. readily agreed.

So, all these plants that the Fulmers had grown and nurtured, were then lovingly transported and transplanted onto Houndslake's fairways and greens. The pond bank across from Dogwood \#7 and \#8 served as the staging area for the potted plants, and there was a greenhouse on site. This area is now part of Peggy Penland's development, Reflections at Houndslake.
